Dover District Cycling and Walking Infrastructure Plan (LCWIP)

Sustrans is working with Dover District Council to develop a Local Cycling and Walking Infrastructure Plan (LCWIP). The LCWIP is a district-wide plan which seeks to connect people and places across the District with safe and accessible routes for everyone.

In 2020 Sustrans conducted a number of 'town audits' in Aylesham, Deal, Sandwich and Dover Town. This LCWIP builds upon the 2020 work and will identify further routes which will help to connect settlements across the District.
