## Qualification requirements

Under the Schedule to the Council Tax (Additional Provisions for Discount Disregards) Regulations 1992

### Part 1,

A carer must be:

- (a) Providing care or support through a connection with the Crown, a charity or a local authority
- (b) Employed for at least 24 hours a week
- (c) Paid no more than £36 a week; and
- (d) Resident where the care is given or in premises which have been provided for the better performance of the work

### Part 2

A carer must be:

Providing care for a person who is entitled to one of the following state benefits:

- (1) a higher rate attendance allowance
  - (2) the highest rate of the care component of a disability living allowance
  - (3) the appropriately increased rate of disablement pension
  - (4) an increase in a constant attendance allowance, and
- (b) resident in the same dwelling as the person to whom care is being provided
  - (c) providing care for at least 35 hours a week on average; and
  - (d) not a disqualified relative of the person being cared for (a spouse, or a parent of the person being cared for, if that person is a child below 18 years old)
