# TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (GENERAL PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT) ORDER 1995

WHEREAS Dover District Council of White Cliffs Business Park Dover Kent CT16 3PJ (hereinafter called "the Council") being the local planning authority for its area within the meaning of Article 4(6) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 ("the 1995 Order") is satisfied that it is expedient that development of the descriptions set out in Schedule II hereto should not be carried out on the land shown delineated and shaded red on the plan annexed hereto and comprising the land described in Schedule I hereto unless permission therefore is granted by the Council on an application made in that behalf under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990

**AND WHEREAS** the Council considers that development of the descriptions set out in Schedule II hereto if carried out would constitute a threat to the amenities of their area and would prejudice the proper planning of the area and that as such the provisions of Article 5(4) of the 1995 Order apply to this Direction.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article 4(1) of the 1995 Order **HEREBY DIRECTS** that the permission granted by Article 3 of the 1995 Order set out in Schedule II hereto shall not apply to the land described in Schedule I and that this Direction may be cited as the "District of Dover (St Margarets) Town and Country Planning Direction Number 1 of 2007".

**THIS DIRECTION** is made under Article 4(1) of the 1995 Order and in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 5(4) of the 1995 Order and shall remain in force until the 27th day of May 2008 (being six months from the date of this Direction) and will then expire unless it has been approved by the Secretary of State before that date.

#### **SCHEDULE I**

All that land shown shaded red on the plan number 052/07 annexed hereto and comprising approximately 1 hectare of land at The White House, St Margarets at Cliffe, Near Dover in the County of Kent.

### SCHEDULE II

(Class E Part 1 of Schedule 2 to the 1995 Order)

The provision within the curtilage of a dwelling-house of any building or enclosure, swimming or other pool required for a purpose incidental to the enjoyment of the dwelling-house as such, or the maintenance, improvement or other alteration of such a building or enclosure, being development comprised within class & of fart of schedule 2 to the said order and not being development comprised within any other class Dated this 27th day of November 2007

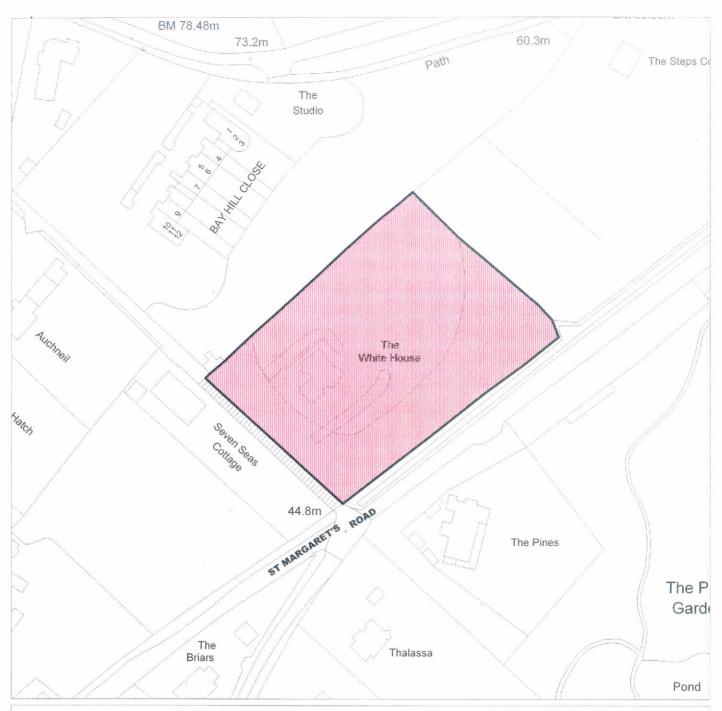
