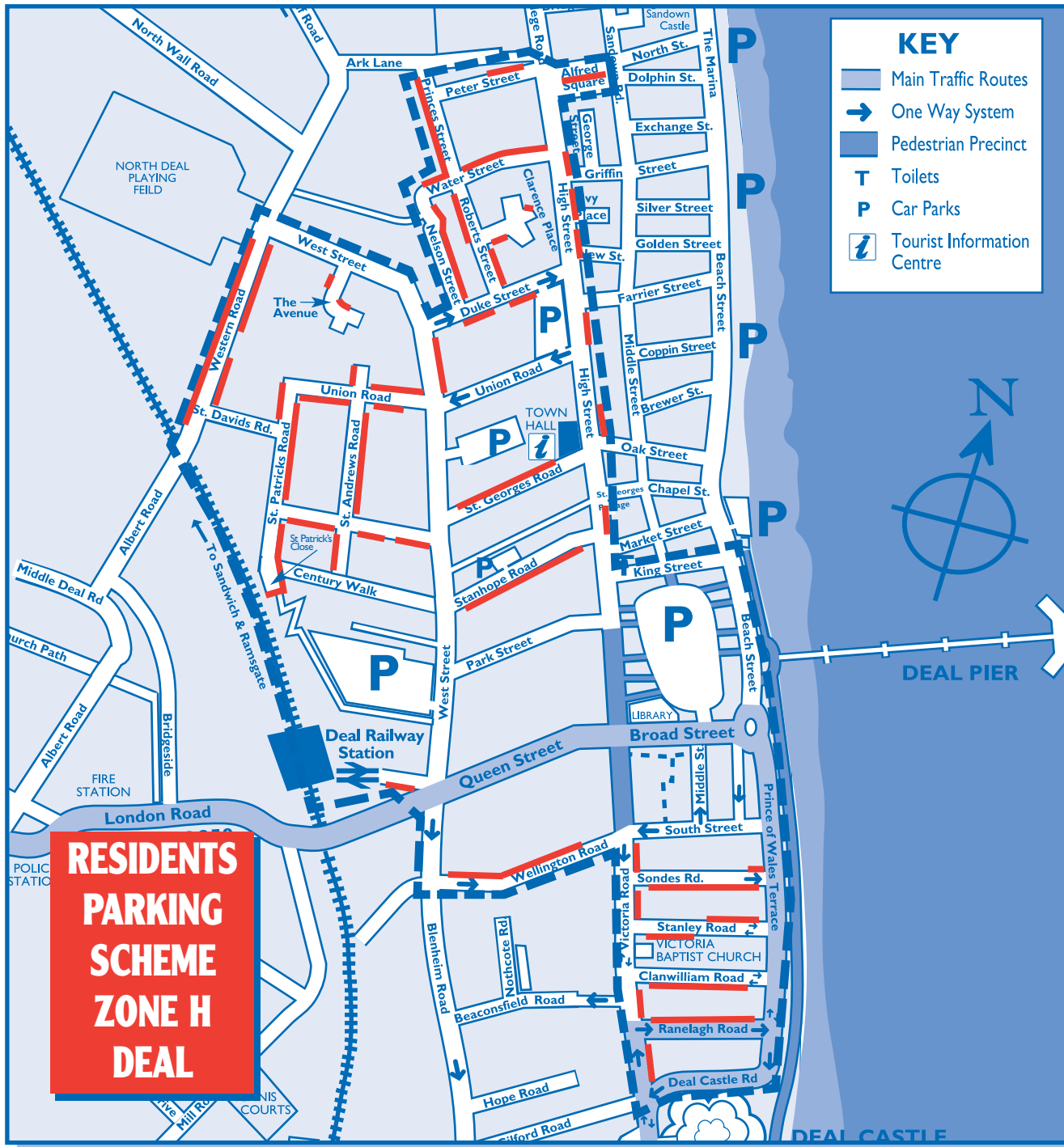

## THE SCHEME

Residents parking schemes are available in some areas of Deal, Dover and Sandwich to assist residents and their visitors to park on the street close to their homes.

Parking bays marked on the street permit parking between 8.30 a.m. and 5.30 p.m. for the times and days shown on the signs in that area. A vehicle displaying a valid resident or visitor permit may be parked without time limit in a marked bay within the zone for which the permit is purchased.

Disabled drivers displaying a valid blue badge may park in a marked bay without time limit in Limited Waiting parking areas and may not require a residents permit.

Please remember the purchase of a permit does not guarantee a space and does not allow parking on yellow lines.

**Who can purchase a Permit?**

You must reside within the boundary of the following addresses to be eligible to purchase a Resident or Visitor Parking Permit for Zone H. The boundary is marked on the map overleaf as dotted blue line.

- College Road (Ark Lane to Alfred Square)
- Victoria Road
- Wellington Road
- Blenheim Road (Wellington Road to Queen Street)
- The Railway Line between Queen Street and Western Road
- Queen Street (to the railway line)
- Western Road (the railway crossing to West Street)
- Beach Street (King Street to Prince of Wales Terrace)
- West Street
- George Alley
- Duke Street
- Nelson Street
- Water Street
- Princes Street (to Ark Lane)
- Peter Street
- Alfred Square
- High Street
- King Street
- Prince of Wales Terrace
- Deal Castle Road
- The Avenue

**Where can I park with a Zone H permit displayed?**

● Zone H Permit – The Resident or Visitor Parking Permit is valid in any residents parking bay within the area. Current roads are marked in **red on the map overleaf**. Please note this permit is not valid for parking in pay and display parking bays within this zone i.e. Prince of Wales Terrace, King Street, Beach Street and Victoria Road.

Residents in the Zone H scheme may opt to purchase a Zone 2 Permit instead of the Zone H Permit. The Zone 2 Permit allows parking in Union Road Car Park, St. George's Car Park, Oak Street Car Park and the pay and display bays along Beach Street (on-street).

**Cost**

- Zone 2 – £60 per annum
- Zone H – £35 per annum (on-street only)
- Visitor Parking Permit: £1 per permit for 1 day's use (Maximum 20 per household per annum)

Households may only purchase one type of Permit – Zone 2 or Zone H

## CONDITIONS OF USE

**Resident's Parking Permit**

1. The permit is valid for a twelve-month period from the first of the month in which the permit is issued, except in the case of renewals.
2. A completed application form, verifying documents and fee is to be presented at the time of application.
3. Permits are only available for motor cars, motorcycles (with or without sidecar) and light vans not exceeding 3500 kgs. in weight.
4. One permit only can be issued for each household, however, one additional permit may be issued upon written request at the discretion of Dover District Council.
5. If two registration numbers appear on the one permit, it must be safely secured to the windscreen of whichever vehicle is being used, as the permit is valid for use in one vehicle at any given time. Any Penalty Charge Notices issued for non-display will not be cancelled.
6. When the permit is in use, it must be clearly displayed on the inside surface of the front windscreen, so that it can easily be seen from the front of the vehicle at all times. In the case of a motorcycle or any vehicle without a windscreen the permit should be securely displayed on the front of the vehicle, facing forwards.
7. The permit can only be replaced in the case of loss, destruction, defacing or through a change of vehicle. An administrative charge of £5 is payable for a replacement permit.
8. Any contravention of the conditions of the Traffic Order, (which is available for inspection during working hours at The Council's local offices) will render the permit invalid and the permit will be withdrawn.
9. The purchase of a permit does not guarantee the availability of a parking space, but will exempt the vehicle from the time restriction within the zone for which the permit has been issued.
10. The permit does not entitle the vehicle to be parked on yellow line restrictions.
11. Refunds will be given on surrender of a permit at a rate of one twelfth of the annual cost for each complete calendar month remaining.

**Visitor's Permits**

1. The number of visitor's permits is restricted to a maximum of 20 per annum, per household.
2. Visitor's permits must be completed with vehicle registration number in ink and appropriate year, month and date panels scratched off. Visitor permits are only available for use on the date stated on the permit.
3. Visitor's permits must be clearly displayed on the inside surface of the front windscreen, or on the dashboard, so that it can easily be seen from the front of the vehicle at all times. In the case of a motorcycle, or any vehicle without a windscreen, the permit should be securely displayed on the front of the vehicle, facing forwards.
4. The purchase of a permit does not guarantee the availability of a parking space, but will exempt the vehicle from the time restriction within the zone for which the permit has been issued.
5. The permit does not entitle the vehicle to be parked on yellow lines.
6. Any contravention of these conditions will result in the withdrawal of any unused visitor's permits issued to that household.
