KCC/DDC Small Community Capital Project Fund 2008/09

All applicants were asked to submit their Small Community Capital Project Fund application forms before a deadline of 29 August 2008. Applications were then sent to Parish Council representatives, Dover District Councillors and Kent County Councillors for scoring.

Projects were then ranked in priority order based on the scores received.

The following list are the grants applicants that we are recommending to the KCC and DDC Cabinet who will make the final decisions on what projects will be funded.

Elvington Village Hall	Grant required to cover the cost of installing security lighting.	£700
Great Mongeham Village Design Statement Group	Village Design Statement	£500
East Kent Railway Trust	Eythorne Station re-surfacing – the current platform surface is in a poor state and is difficult to walk on. The aim is to provide a smooth, level tarmac platform surface.	£1,800
St Augustine's Church, East Langdon	Installation of toilet facilities.	£1,650
Aylesham Neighbourhood Project	Replacement of old windows in the playroom.	£3,395
Ripple Down House Trust	Fence Project which aims to remove existing oak fencing and replace with sustainably produced timber together with fence posts where necessary.	£5,000
Move the Miner	Funding required for creating a new site for the miners statue, preparing the site, security measures. It is also intended to purchase 4 smaller statues to present to the other areas to commemorate the moving of the statue.	£576.71
