**Access to Information Procedure Rules
Notice of Decision taken under the General Exception Procedure**

A: Decision Taken

To agree a Deed of Variation for the Aylesham Expansion Scheme. This decision to be taken by Cabinet on 17 August 2009. The decision needs to be taken before Planning Committee on 27 August. It is impracticable to defer the decision until the start of the first month to which the next Forward Plan relates.

B: Part of the Constitution authorising the decision

Rule 15 (General Exception Procedure) of the Access to Information Procedure Rules (Part 4 – Rules of Procedure).

C: Subject (including whether it is a key decision)

To agree a Deed of Variation to the Aylesham Expansion Development Agreement. This is a Key Decision and is required because of the current economic climate which makes the current scheme economically unviable. Changes are being proposed to ensure the scheme can continue.

D: Details of Consultation

The Portfolio Holder for Economy and Special Projects has been consulted. Dover District Council is the landowner and at this stage needs to decide whether the proposed Deed of Variation is acceptable. Any material change to the Aylesham Scheme will be submitted to Planning and undergo consultation as part of that process.
