**Access to Information Procedure Rules  
Notice of Decision taken under the General Exception Procedure**

**A: Decision Taken**

To give notice of a Key Decision which has not been included within the Forward Plan as the decision must be taken by such a date that it is impracticable to defer the decision until the start of the first month to which the next Forward Plan relates.

This Key Decision will be taken by Cabinet at its meeting to be held on 3 November 2008.

**B: Part of the Constitution authorising the decision**

Rule 15 (General Exception Procedure) of the Access to Information Procedure Rules (Part 4 – Rules of Procedure).

**C: Subject (including whether it is a key decision)**

Bede & Dunstan Houses, College Road, Deal – a Key Decision.

Cabinet is being asked at its meeting on 3 November 2008 to decide on the disposal of these former sheltered properties to SEEDA (South East England Development Agency).

The closure and disposal of these properties was considered and approved by Cabinet on 2 June 2008 (decision number CAB 25) and reaffirmed by Cabinet on 7 July 2008 (decision number CAB 37). Council considered and approved this item at its meeting held on 9 July 2008 (Minute No. 128).

(This matter was notified as a key decision when the principle of disposal was considered by Cabinet on 2 June 2008.)

**D: Details of Consultation**

Extensive consultation took place over the proposed disposal of these sites, both with scheme residents but more generally with town and parish councils. The outcome of these discussions was reported to Cabinet on 2 June 2008.
