

What is the Inspire Families Project?

The Inspire Families Project is a project that will enable families to take part in activities that would usually be unattainable due to finances or personal circumstances. By providing families with support through these activities, we aim to improve family cohesion and improve the wellbeing of the family unit.

Who is the Inspire Families Project open to?

The Inspire Families Project is open to any family that lives within the Dover district who is experiencing difficulties such as family breakdown, bereavement, illness or simply financial pressures, which is preventing them from partaking in fun activities that help with family bonding.

What is a referral partner?

A referral partner is a professional or organisation who works with young people and their families. This could be a school, community group, local authority, police, social services, or similar. The referral partners will have recognised the need for a referral to Inspire Families Project and will complete the form on their behalf, with them.

What are delivery partners?

Delivery partners are organisations that run sessions or activities which people on the **Inspire Families Project** take part in. All our delivery partners are based within the Dover District and are all qualified to deliver their activities.

Responsibilities of referral partners

- To ensure the family are in need of the project and can explain what the benefits to the family would be
- To ensure the family are able to attend on the dates given in the activity pack, both in terms of transport and availability on the day, at the time of referring
- To complete pre-evaluation form with the family as part of the referral form process.

Responsibilities of the Inspire Families Project

- To ensure the families are benefitting from the activities
- To follow up and gain measurable feedback within a certain time period after completion of the activity pack.

The families' responsibilities

- To ensure they are choosing an activity pack that they think will best benefit them as a family
- To attend the sessions and If they can't, to notify the delivery partner with 24 hours notice
- To always respect the staff and other attendees whilst partaking in the activities
- To confirm they will give feedback via text message at the end of the programme.

Important note...

Due to high demand for all of our activities, please ensure that if you are unable to attend a session that you notify the delivery partner with 24 hours notice so they can fill the slot. If you don't do this on 2 occasions you may be removed from the Inspire families project.

Who can be referred?

A family who the referral partner feels needs support to overcome issues that are affecting them as a family and meets the criteria stated in this leaflet. Before the form is submitted, the referral partner will need to discuss the project with the family. It is the responsibility of the referral partner to determine what activity the family would like to take part in. The referral form can be found via the following link;
