

DOVER SENIOR CITIZENS FORUM IS A WELL ESTABLISHED LOCAL FORUM FOR RESIDENTS OVER THE AGE OF 55 WHO LIVE IN THE DOVER DISTRICT AND SURROUNDING VILLAGES. MEMBERSHIP IS FREE.

WHAT DO WE DO: Twice a year we hold open meetings in the Dover area to which all members and friends are invited and where there are speakers on a range of subjects; recent meetings have included speakers from Hi Kent, work of the Care Navigator, Family Mosaic, CROP (Citizens Rights for Older People), work of Health watch, Carers' Support, Creative Legal Solutions (about enduring Power of Attorney) Scam and Rogue Traders talks by local Community Warden. Over the past two years we have also held meetings in Deal and would like to branch out to the rural areas.


