Remember our Blue Planet

Please don't drop your litter. Put it in the bin, or take it home. We don't want any more plastic ending up in the sea.



Keep the Pier a Clean Plaice (get it?)

Please don't prepare bait or gut fish on the seating or pier surface. Use a bucket or tarpaulin, and always remember to clear up. Take your catch home.



Tackle cleanly (another one for the anglers!)

Please don't leave fishing tackle, such as line, weights or hooks, lying on the pier.



Fishing permits required.

We thank you for not fishing where the handrails are painted yellow.



We don't like it hot

Please don't use BBQs or stoves on the pier.



Don't drink like a fish!

Please drink responsibly. You may be asked to leave if excessive drinking causing a nuisance to other pier users.



Lead the way

Four-legged friends are welcome on the pier, but please keep dogs on a short lead.



Pier Safety

The Pier is a great place for young ones to visit, but please keep a careful eye on children. Don't let them stand on the seating or railings, or get too close to the edge.



Do not jump or dive into the sea from the pier. There are rocks and other submerged objects below the surface. The tidal current around the pier is very strong, not to mention the cold temperature of the sea.
