WHEREAS the Council of the District of Dover being the appropriate local planning authority within the meaning of Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1988 are satisfied that it is expedient that development of the description set out in the Schedule hereto should not be carried out on areas of land situated within the Middle Street Conservation Area Deal in the County of Kent being the areas of land shown and edged red on plan number 087/90 annexed hereto unless permission therefor is granted on application made under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 AND WHEREAS the Council are further satisfied that development of the said description would be prejudicial to the proper planning of their area and would constitute a threat to the amenities of their area and that the provisions of Article 5 paragraph (4) of the said Order should apply to this direction NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by the said Article 4 hereby direct that the permission granted by Article 3 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1988 shall not apply to development on the said lands of the description set out in the Schedule hereto THIS DIRECTION is made in pursuance of the provisions of paragraph (4) of the said Article 5 and shall remain in force until 14 November 1990

being six months from the date on which this direction is made and

will then expire unless it has been disallowed or approved by the

Secretary of State for the Environment before that date
