Who we are

Dover District Council will act as the 'Data Controller' in regard to the personal data you provide to us. The 'Data Controller' is based at Dover District Council, White Cliffs Business Park, Dover, Kent CT16 3PJ. Dover District Council is also the 'Data Processor', and officers in the Planning Policy team will process your data.

Information

The information we collect from you will include details such as name, address, employment status, household composition etc and will also include special category data including information regarding disability, health and ethnicity data. Purpose

If you consent to give us your information, then this will be used to recruit and maintain a register of Panel members who will be invited to take part in Community Panel workshops, and potentially in future feedback surveys. This is to allow the Council to work collaboratively with a representative sample of local residents and businesses to develop a Design Code to be used in decision-making on planning applications.

Throughout the lifetime of your membership of the Community Panel and your participation in workshops and surveys, the information you provide will be used for the following purposes:

- to identify and communicate with you;
- to assess your suitability for inclusion in the Community Panel;
- to ensure that membership of the Community Panel is broadly representative of the population of Dover;
- to understand access requirements for workshops/surveys; and
- for statistical monitoring of the composition of the Community Panel.

The Council will not pass on your details to any other business or individual, other than for the purpose of developing the Design Code.

How long will we keep your information?

We only keep your personal information for the minimum period of time necessary, in accordance with our retention policy as described in our privacy policy **Your Privacy**.

Personal data belonging to individuals who are not initially selected for the Community Panel will be kept for up to 1 year after the recruitment of the Panel, to invite individuals to join the Panel should an existing member need to leave prematurely. After this time, personal data will be securely deleted in accordance with the Council's Privacy Policy Your Privacy
