## **Background and scope of project**

In 2021 Dover District Council was awarded £3.2m from the Future High Street Fund, and with match funding of £1.7m from the Council has a total budget of £4.9m to:


- Build a creative centre
- Make improvements to the A20 Underpass

# A proportion of this budget will aim to deliver the proposed improvements:

- Re-painting of the walls and railings
- Re-surfacing of the footpaths and cycleways in the underpass
- Possible vinyl enhancements to the tiles in the underpass
- Investigate opportunities to improve CCTV coverage in and around the surrounding area
- Improve signage around the underpass

The underpass structure is owned by National Highways, maintenance and other aspects are under Kent County Council Highways. To resolve design matters for the underpass and infrastructure we have been working with National Highways, Kent County Council, Kent Downs Organisation, Sus Trans, and other key stakeholders to formulate possible options for this consultation.

# **Consultation Options**

Dover District Council are not able to make any alterations that could affect the integrity of the physical structure of the underpass. However we would like to make some cosmetic improvements to the tiles within the underpass structure and appreciate your feedback.

We are proposing to overlay the current tiles in the underpass with vinyl to refresh and brighten the look in the underpass. The possible options are illustrated below.


#### **Option 1: Dover Time Tunnel**

#### **Option 2: Dover Selfie Bunker**

#### **Option 3: Refreshed Tradition**




The current underpass has been in place for almost 40 years. Option 3 is to revitalise and refresh the existing graphics ready to serve the future.


