Notice is hereby given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL intend to make the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act:

If made the effect of the Order will be to further amend Kent County Council (Various Roads, Dover District) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Order 2005 as follows:

Disabled persons vehicle parking places

Parking places for disabled person's vehicles will be provided in the following locations -

DEAL – Across the frontages of 13 Albert Road, 63 Canute Road, 50 St Francis Close, 33 Leas Road and 124 Rectory Road; opposite 12 Delane Road.

DOVER – Across the frontages of 21 Avenue Road, 71 Barton Road, 68 Brookfield Avenue, 17 Castlemount Road, 18 Devonshire Road, 5 Dour Street, 20 Fulbert Road, 10 Millais Road, 20 Monins Road and 22 Winchelsea Terrace; along Winant Way (adjacent to walkway between Colorado Close and Maine Close).

ST MARGARETS – Adjacent to 26 Reach Close.

WALMER – Across the frontage of 9 Poets Walk; opposite 55 Churchill Avenue.

The parking places for disabled persons vehicles in the vicinity of the following addresses will be removed – 9 Chilton Square, Ash; 20 Balfour Road, 21 Churchill Road, 45 Devonshire Road, 26 Magdala Road, 22 Leyburne Road, 71 Longfield Road, 11 Noahs Ark Road and 79 Salisbury Road, Dover; 346 London Road, 38 St Martin's Road, 98 Stockdale Gardens and 16 Wellington Road, Deal; 25 Cross Road, Walmer
