Notice is hereby given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL intend to make the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act:

If made the effect of the Order will be to further amend Kent County Council (Various Roads, Dover District) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Order 2005 as follows :

**DOVER
RESIDENTS' PARKING**

It is proposed to introduce residents' parking places in sections of Harold Street, Leyburne Road, Taswell Close and Taswell Street. Residents' Permit holders will be permitted to park without limit of time. Non-permit holders will be limited to 2 hours free parking (No return within 4 hours) between 8.30am and 5.30pm on Mondays to Saturdays. Harold Street, Leyburne Road, Taswell Close and Taswell Street residents may apply for a maximum of two permits per residence.

**DOVER
PROHIBITION OF WAITING**

Leyburne Road, Taswell Close and Taswell Street – it is proposed there will be double yellow lines (No waiting at any time) in any lengths of public highway which are not marked as parking bays.

Harold Street – it is proposed there will be a single yellow line (No waiting Monday-Saturday 8.30am-5.30pm) on the north-eastern side between points 15 metres and 72 metres and bet 76 metres and 114 metres south-east of Godwyne Road. There will be double yellow lines (No waiting at any time) in any lengths which are not marked either as single yellow lines or as parking bays.

DISABLED PERSONS VEHICLE PARKING PLACES

Parking places for disabled persons vehicles will be provided in the following locations

ASH - opposite 11 Holness Close, outside 24 Molland Close

The Kent County Council, in exercise of their powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

A. The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Dover District) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Order 2005 Shall have effect as though:

In the Articles of the Order

DESIGNATION OF PARKING PLACES

Article 24 will be deleted and replaced with

- 24 Each area on a highway comprising the lengths of carriageway described in Schedules 3.00, 3.01, 3.02, 3.21, 3.22 and 5.20 to this Order and, unless otherwise so described, bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway and having a width throughout of not less than 1.8 metres, is designated as a shared parking place.

Article 41 to be deleted and replaced with

Shared parking places

41. SAVE as provided in Part H of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or with the permission of a parking attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours and during the days specified in any of the parking places described in Schedules 3, 3.01, 3.02, 3.21, 3.22 and 5.2 to this Order:-
- (a) for longer than the hours specified; or
 - (b) if a period less than that specified in the appropriate schedule has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle in that length of road.

Other than a vehicle which is displaying in the relevant position:-

- (c) A valid Residents' Parking Permit issued in accordance with Part K of this Order; or
- (d) A valid Visitors' Parking Permit validated in respect of that vehicle for the Zone in which that Parking Place is situated
