**THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, DOVER DISTRICT) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (No. 64) ORDER 2019**

Notice is hereby given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL intend to make the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act:

If made the effect of the Order will be to further amend Kent County Council (Various Roads, Dover District) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Order 2005 as follows :

**Dover**

**RESIDENTS' PARKING**

It is proposed to INTRODUCE A RESIDENTS' PARKING SCHEME (**Zone G Residents Parking Zone**) where general parking will be limited to 2 hours (with no return permitted within 4 hours) between 8.30am and 5.30pm on Mondays - Saturdays. Permit holders will be permitted to park without limitation of time. The cost of a residents' parking permit will be £60 per annum and visitors permits will cost £2 each (maximum 20 per household per year). Residents' Parking Permits will be available for motor cars and certain light goods vehicles but will not be valid for caravans or other trailers. Motor cycles will be exempt.

**Victoria Park**

Residents parking places will be provided on both sides of Victoria Park, between the existing double yellow lines, and in the parking area on the northern side between 4 metres and 11 metres east of Heritage Gardens (with vehicles parked at right angles to the kerb) . A 2.5 metre length of double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) will be provided on the north eastern side outside The Gatehouse (across the pedestrian gate). A 19 metre length of double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) passing place will be provided on the north eastern side opposite 13 and 14 Victoria Park

**Laureston Place**

Residents parking places will be provided on the north-eastern side from the junction with Harold Passage to 14 metres north of Castle Hill Road. A 15 metre length of double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) passing place will be provided on the north eastern side opposite 5 and 6 Laureston Place. Double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) will apply on the entire length of the western side.

**Castle Street, Castle Hill Road** - Residents parking places will be moved from Zone F to Zone G

**Zone G** will comprise Ashen Tree Lane (part); Castle Street (part); Castle Hill Road (part of) Laureston Place and Victoria Park.

**LIMITED WAITING**

**Elizabeth Street** - On street parking place for cars and motorcycles only will be provided on the south-eastern and north-eastern sides, from a point 7 metres south west , to a point 30 metres north west, of the southeastern-most corner of the kerb line. Additionally, in the same parking place, between 8am – 6pm parking will be limited to 2 hours max stay (no return within 4 hours)

**LORRY PARKING**

Branch Street - Goods vehicles exceeding 7.5 tonnes will be prohibited from parking/waiting on the south-western side of Branch Street between 7.6 metres from its junction with Bridge Street and its junction with Peter Street.

Full details are contained in the draft Order which, together with a copy of any orders which will be amended by the proposed Order, and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at The Council Offices, White Cliffs Business Park, Dover.

Information relating to the proposals will be available for inspection at the District Council Office located Dover Gateway, Castle Street, Dover during normal office hours from Friday 20 September, and on the Dover District Council web site [www.dover.gov.uk/parking](http://www.dover.gov.uk/parking).

The Kent County Council, in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

A. The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Dover District) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Order 2005 ('the Order') shall have effect as though:

In the Articles of the Order

**AUTHORISATION OF PARKING PLACES**

Articles 28 to be deleted and replaced with

28. Each area on a highway comprising the lengths of carriageway described Schedules 3.1, 3.3, 3.31, 3.4, 3.6, 3.7 and 3.8 to this Order and having the appropriate signs and markings prescribed in Schedules 2 and 6 of The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002, is authorised as a limited waiting parking place.

**USE OF PARKING PLACES**

Article 37 to be deleted and replaced with

**Limited waiting parking places**

37. SAVE as provided in Part H of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or with the permission of a parking attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the parking places described in Schedules 3.1, 3.3, 3.31, 3.4, 3.6, 3.7 and 3.8 to this Order.
- (a) For a longer period than the hours specified; or
- (b) If a period of less than the amount of time specified in the appropriate schedule has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle in that length of road.

**Schedule 1 - NO WAITING AT ANY TIME**

**Roads in Dover in the District of Dover**

**ELIZABETH STREET**

The item in the First Schedule relating to Elizabeth Street, Dover, to be deleted and replaced with:-

- (1) On the south-western and north-western sides from a point opposite the centre line of Bulwark Street north-eastwards and north-westwards to the junction with A20 Trunk Road.

- (2) On the south-eastern and eastern sides from the centre line of Bulwark Street eastwards and northwards for a distance of 70 metres including on both sides of the turning area, but excluding the length between points 11 metres east of the entrance to the electricity sub station and 24 metres north of the southern kerbline.
- (3) On the north-eastern side from a point 112 metres north-eastwards then north-westwards from the centre line of Bulwark Street to the junction with A20 Trunk Road.

#### **LAURESTON PLACE**

The item in the First Schedule relating to Laureston Place, Dover, to be deleted and replaced with:-

- (1) On the eastern side
  - (a) from the junction with Victoria Park to a point in line with the southern side of Harold Passage;
  - (b) from a point in line with the southern boundary of 7 Laureston Place for a distance of 15 metres in a southerly direction;
  - (c) from the junction with Castle Hill Road for a distance of 14 metres in a northerly direction.
- (2) On the western side for the entire length.

#### **VICTORIA PARK**

The item in the First Schedule relating to Victoria Park, Dover, to be deleted and replaced with :-

- (1) On both sides from its junction with Laureston Place to a point in line with the boundary wall of 25/26 Victoria Park.
- (2) On the north-eastern side from its junction with Castle Hill Road to a point opposite the boundary of 3/4 Victoria Park.
- (3) On the south-western side from its junction with Castle Hill Road to a point 2 metres south-east of the boundary of 1/2 Victoria Park.

#### **Schedule 3.22 - LIMITED WAITING MON-SAT 8.30am - 5.30pm 2 HOURS IN ANY PERIOD OF 4 HOURS EXCEPT FOR PERMIT HOLDERS.**

##### **Roads in Dover in the District of Dover**

The following shall be added to the Third Schedule in correct alphabetical sequence:-

#### **LAURESTON PLACE**

On the eastern side

- (a) from a point in line with the southern side of Harold Passage to a point in line with the southern boundary of 7 Laureston Place;
- (b) from a point 15 metres south of a point in line with the southern boundary of 7 Laureston Place to a point 14 metres north of the junction with Castle Hill Road.

## **VICTORIA PARK**

- (1) On the northern side (at right angles to the road) in the parking area 4 metres and 11 metres east of Heritage Gardens;
- (2) On the north-eastern side
  - (a) from a point opposite the boundary wall of 25/26 Victoria Park to a point opposite the boundary of 14/15 Victoria Park;
  - (b) from a point 19 metres south-east of the boundary of 14/15 Victoria Park to a point opposite the boundary of 3/4 Victoria Park.
- (3) On the south-eastern side from a point in line with the boundary wall of 25/26 Victoria Park to a point 2 metres south-east of the boundary of 1/2 Victoria Park.

### **Schedule 3.80 - LIMITED WAITING (RESTRICTED TO CARS AND MOTOR CYCLES ONLY) 8.00am - 6.00pm - 2 HOURS (NO RETURN WITHIN 4 HOURS)**

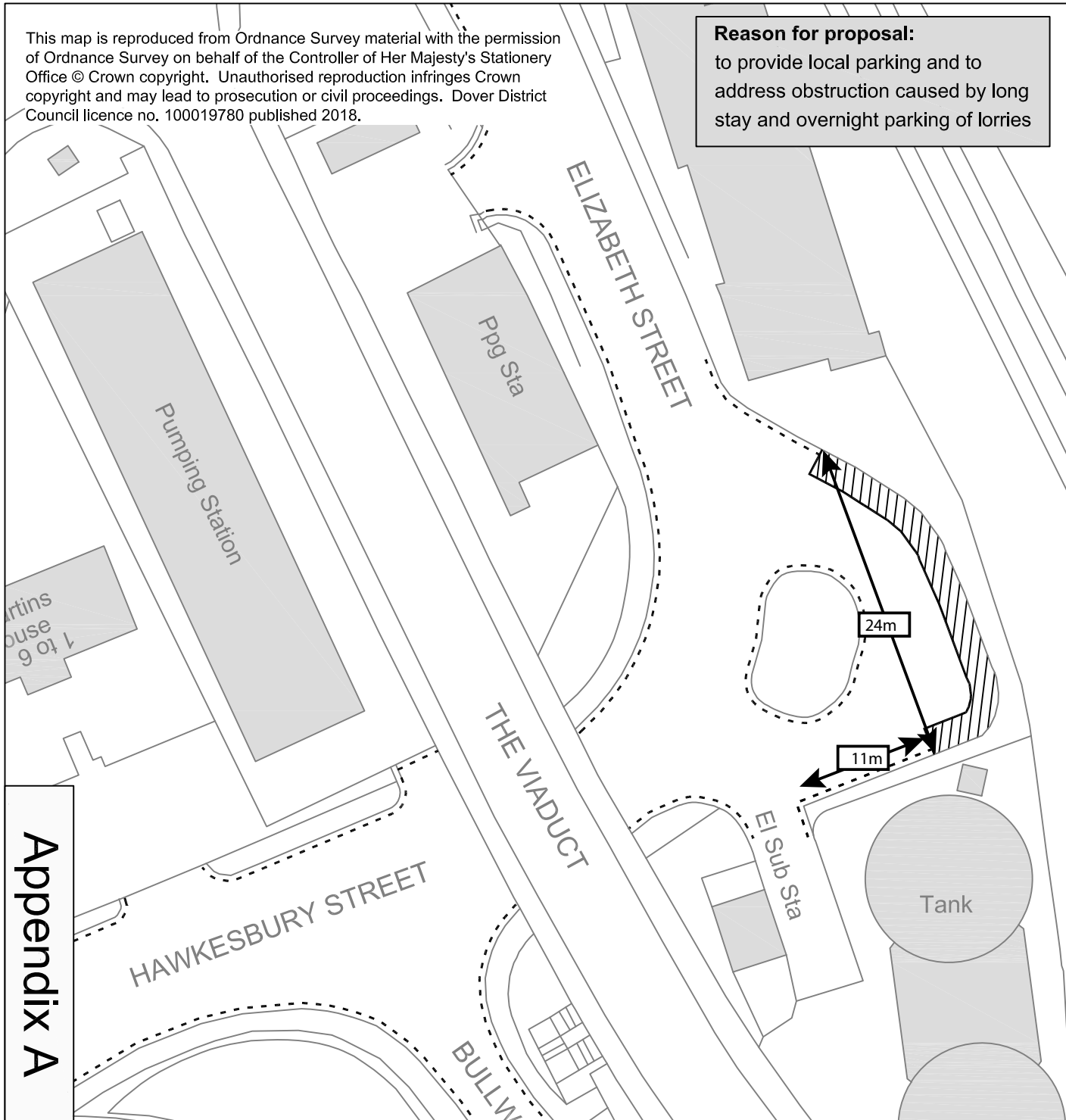

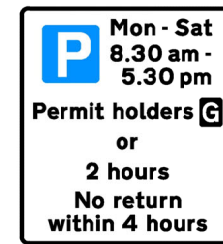

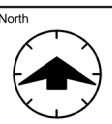

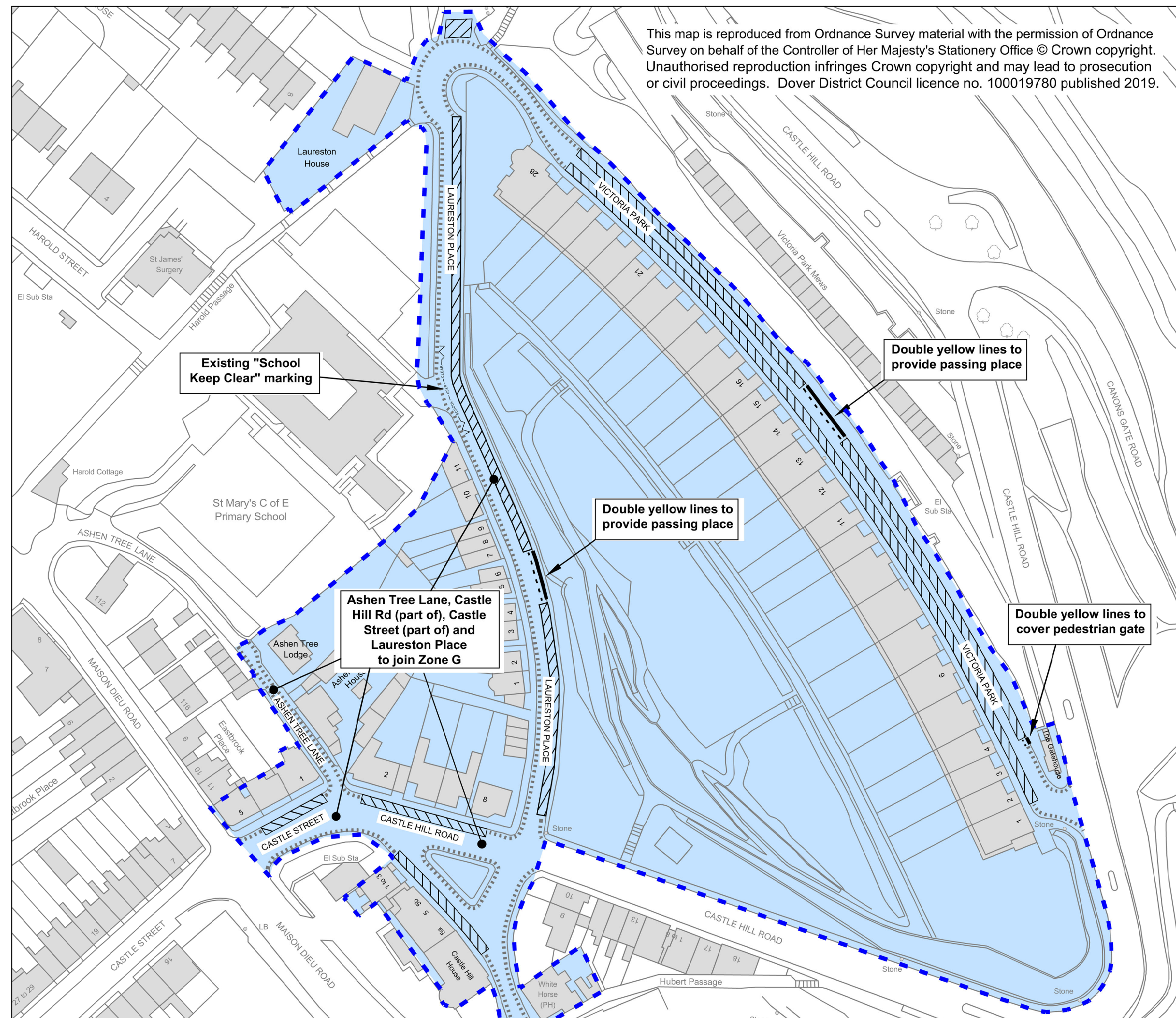

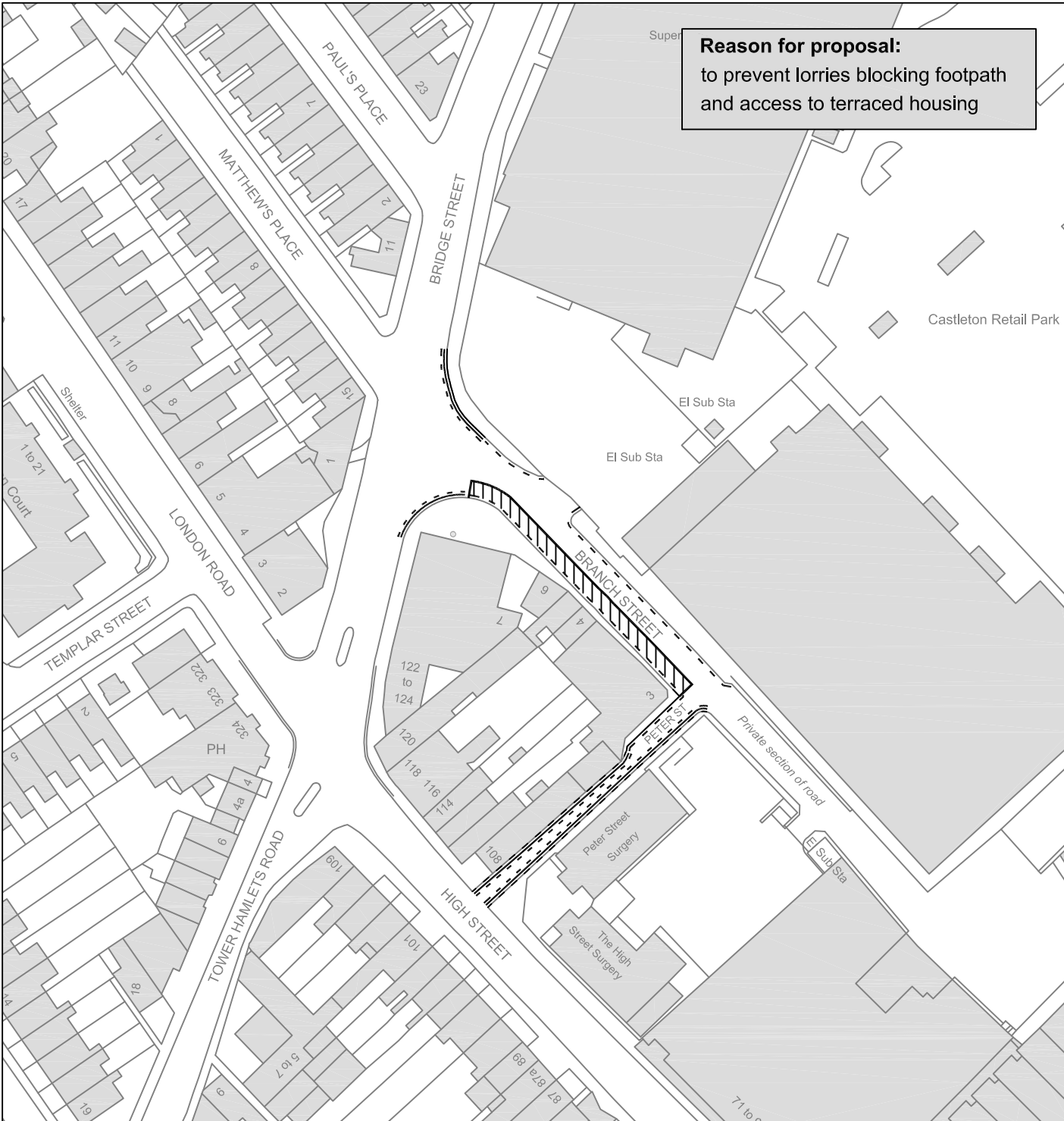


