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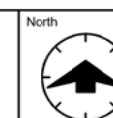

NORTHCOTE ROAD, DEAL

Kent County Council, as traffic authority, propose to make the above named Order the effect of which will be to change existing or introduce new parking or waiting restrictions as follows:

It is proposed to INTRODUCE A RESIDENTS' PARKING SCHEME with parking bays on the western side of Northcote Road from the southern boundary of 2 Northcote Road and the existing turning area at the northern end. Double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) will apply where there are no parking bays.

General parking will be limited to 2 hours (with no return permitted within 1 hour) between 8.30am and 5.30pm on Mondays - Saturdays. Permit holders will be permitted to park without limitation of time. The cost of a residents' parking permit will be £60 per annum and visitors permits will cost £2 each (maximum 20 per household per year). Residents' Parking Permits will be available for motor cars and certain light goods vehicles but will not be valid for caravans or other trailers.

Full details are contained in the draft Order which, together with a copy of any orders which will be amended by the proposed Order, and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at The Council Offices, White Cliffs Business Park, Dover.

Information relating to the proposals will be available for inspection at the District Council Office located Dover Gateway, Castle Street, Dover during normal office hours, and on the Dover District Council web site www.dover.gov.uk/parking.
