THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, DOVER DISTRICT) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (No. 59) ORDER 2018

Notice is hereby given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL intend to make the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act:

If made the effect of the Order will be to further amend Kent County Council (Various Roads, Dover District) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Order 2005 as follows :

Deal

Zone N Residents Parking Zone - Beechwood Ave, Mill Road (part of), London Rd (part of), Astor Drive

Beechwood Avenue

Residents parking places will be provided on the south-western side of Beechwood Avenue, between the existing double yellow lines. Double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) will then apply along the whole of the north-eastern side.

Astor Drive

Residents parking places will be provided on the north-eastern side of Astor Drive, between 15 metres from London Road and the turning area at the side of 5 Astor Drive, and on the south-western side outside 10 Astor Drive. Double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) will apply where there are no parking bays.

Mill Road

A Residents parking place (33 metres in length) will be provided fronting 1-5 Mill Road. The double yellow lines on the north-western side which currently terminate outside 16 Mill Road will be extended to a new terminal point in line with the boundary of 34/36 Mill Road. Double yellow lines 13 metres in length will also be marked on the south-eastern side approximately opposite 32 Mill Road.

London Road

Double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) on the southern side will be extended westwards to cover the junction with Astor Drive

Zone L Residents Parking Zone - Northcote Road

Northcote Road

Residents parking places will be provided on the western side of Northcote Road from the southern boundary of 2 Northcote Road and the existing turning area at the northern end. Double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) will apply where there are no parking bays.

Dover

Zone M Residents Parking Zone - Priory Hill and Priory Grove

Priory Hill

Residents parking places will be provided on the north-eastern and northern sides from High Street to outside 32 except where there are existing double yellow lines; and on the south-western side from the end of the existing double yellow lines near Priory Grove to outside 21 Priory Hill. Double yellow lines will be marked for 10 metres each side of the bend outside 23 Priory Hill.

Priory Grove

The existing residents parking places in Priory Grove will be joined unchanged to Zone M.

Parking in residents parking places will be restricted to 2 hours, with no return within 4 hours in Zones M and N and 1 hour in Zone L, between 8.30am and 5.30pm on Mondays to Saturdays except by

permit holders, who may park without time limit. The current annual charge for a residents parking permit is £60.

Coach Parking

the following parking places which are currently **Pay and Display Parking Places for Motor Cars (Including Goods Vehicle Up to 3500kg), Motor Cycles and Invalid Carriages** will become **Pay and Display parking places for Buses** with a tariff of £7.50 per 24 hours.

Waterloo Crescent

Three existing car parking spaces on both sides of Waterloo Crescent fronting and opposite 50-60 Harbour House.

Marine Parade

Six existing car parking spaces on the northern side of Marine Parade immediately east of Douro Place.

Whitfield

Fitness Fields

Waiting will be prohibited at all times (DYL) on both sides for the entire length.

Disabled Persons Vehicle Parking Places

Parking places for disabled persons vehicles will be provided in the vicinity of 7 Dorman Avenue North, 17 Elm Road, 58 Hill Crescent, 48 Milner Crescent, Aylesham; 69 Birdwood Avenue, 18 Canute Road, 68 Davis Avenue, 71 Freemans Way, 60 The Marina, Deal; 5 Selkirk Road & 16 Niagara House, 30 Astley Avenue, 140 Buckland Avenue, 6a Cherry Tree Avenue, 21 Churchill Road, 77 Elms Vale Road, 118 Elms Vale Road, 4 Milton Road, 38 Noahs Ark Road, 95 Priory Hill, 8 Priory Hill, 34 St Georges Crescent, 17 St Radigunds Road, 3 Wyndham Road, Dover; 17 Mill Green, Eastry; 2 Park View, Goodnestone; 36 Stonehall Road, Lydden; 4 Church Street, Nonnington; 87 and 178 Lewisham Road, River and 46 Churchill Avenue, Walmer.

Redundant parking places in the vicinity of 36 & 40 Hill Crescent, Aylesham; 63, 73 and 74 Church Lane, 4 Downs Road and 12 Northcote Road, Deal; 10 De Burgh Street, 152 Folkestone Road, 10 George Street, 18 Kitchener Road, 116 Longfield Road, 62 Manor Road, 23, 26, 39 and 105 Markland Road, 75 Old Folkestone Road, 45 Oswald Road, 103 Priory Hill, and 126 Snargate Street, Dover and 16 Templar Road, Temple Ewell, will be removed

A. The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Dover District) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Order 2005 ('the Order') shall have effect as though:

ASTOR DRIVE

The item in the First Schedule relating to Astor Drive, Deal, to be deleted and replaced with :-

On both sides for the entire length (except in parking places).

The following shall be added to the Third Schedule as

Schedule 3.22 - LIMITED WAITING MON-SAT 8.30am - 5.30pm 2 HOURS IN ANY PERIOD OF 4 HOURS EXCEPT FOR PERMIT HOLDERS.

ASTOR DRIVE

on the north-eastern side from a point 15 metres south-east of the junction with London Road south-eastwards and north-eastwards to the limit of the highway.
